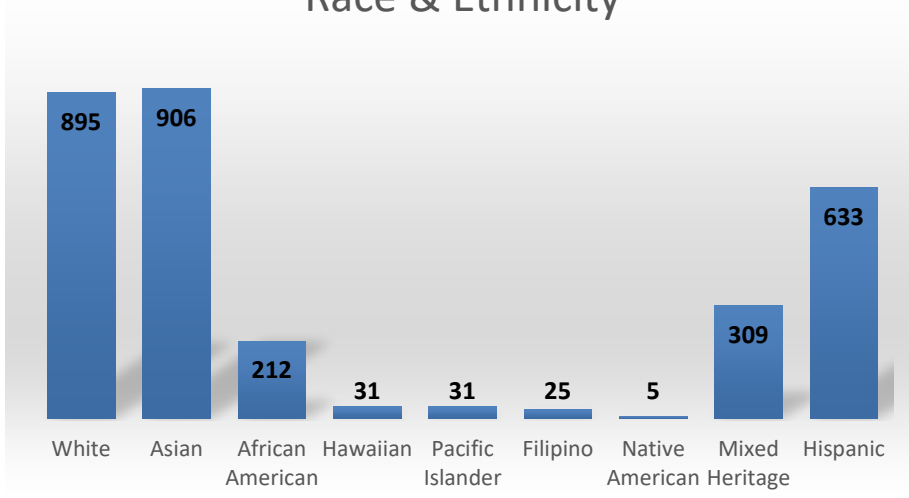

Race & Ethnicity



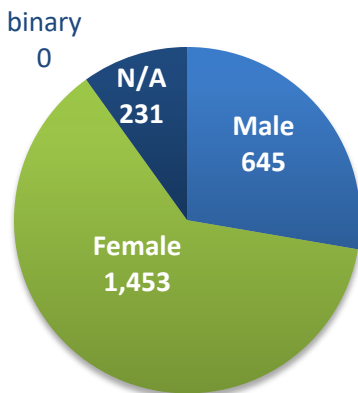
NATIONAL ORIGIN and LANGUAGE

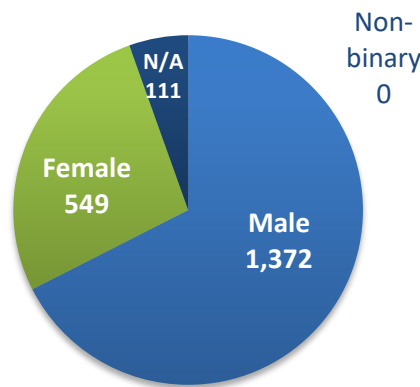

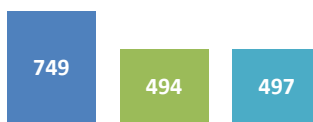
